# Memorandum of Understanding Signed with Baghdati, Tkibuli, and Terjola Municipalities

Local Democracy Agency Georgia, in partnership with the Tkibuli District Development Fund, has initiated the "More Transparency and Accountability for Effective Self-Government" project. This project aims to foster effective selfgovernance in Terjola, Tkibuli, and Baghdati municipalities, emphasizing the engagement of civil society in decision-making processes. A key milestone in this initiative is the signing of a memorandum of understanding between LDA Georgia, the Tkibuli District Development Fund, and the target municipalities: Baghdati, Terjola, and Tkibuli. This agreement was formalized by the leaders of these organizations and the mayors of the respective municipalities.

The project, led by the Tkibuli District Development Fund in partnership with LDA Georgia, is supported by the "Strengthening Civil Society in the Eastern Partnership" program. This program receives joint funding from the government of the Federal Republic of Germany and the European Union.


