Training for the youth council of Baghdati municipality

The club was established by LDA Georgia within the framework of the project "Civil Society STAR Initiative," with the support of the European Union and the Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung

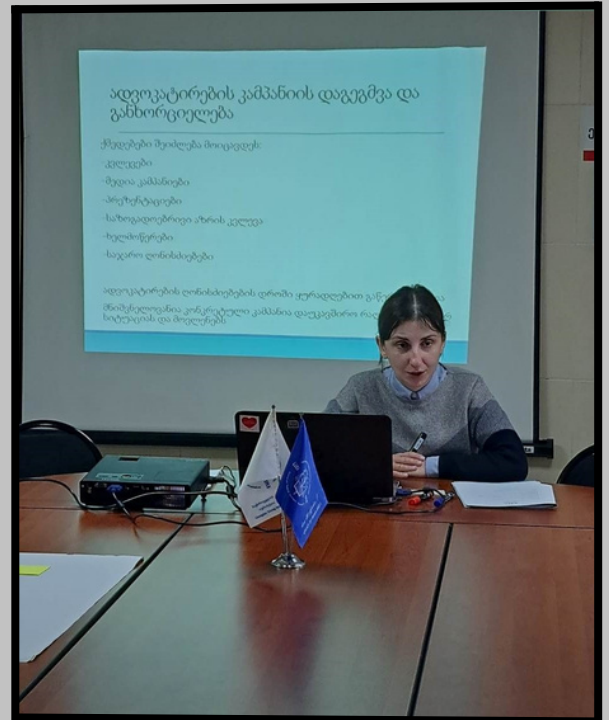
Training on advocacy campaign
