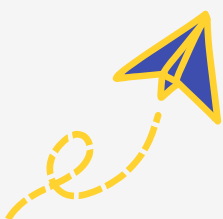

Assessing/studying the needs of civil society

Imereti Regional Hub periodically assesses the needs of civil society so that the activities planned within the project respond to the needs of civil society organizations at the regional level.



A questionnaire consisting of 20 questions was developed and sent to civil society organizations in the Imereti region. At this stage, the received answers are being processed and analyzed.

In 2020-2021, LDA Georgia covered 3365 beneficiaries.



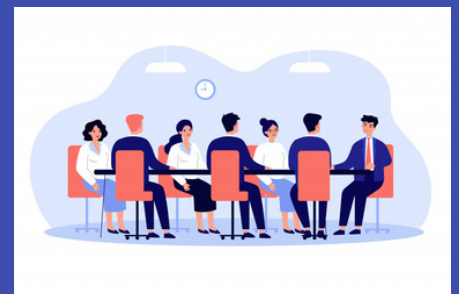
96 Consultations
